How to Enter

Register online at www.horseshowtime.com

A deposit via credit card online is required at the time of submission of your entry. In addition, you must have all fields completed, including all class entries. All information is required for entry to be considered complete. Your credit card will be charged a \$50 office and any stabling fees immediately upon receipt of your entry. These are non-refundable. Any remaining balance, including added classes, will automatically be charged at the end of the show to the card on file. You are welcome to visit the office to check your statement if you would like to, prior to the end of the show on Sunday. There will be a \$25 NSF charge for all declined cards.

Entries will close on May 7th, or when space is full. **BE SURE TO GET YOUR ENTRIES IN EARLY!**

All show ribbons/prizes/back numbers can be picked up at the office at the south end of the main arena building (Club Room).

There will be an information booth to get your stall assignments.

NO DOGS ALLOWED

Hunters will be in the indoor arena, Jumpers will be in the main outdoor arena. Schooling will be in the covered arena.

RULES

Parking in designated areas only. Do not park by the barns or show arenas.

No horse may enter more than two divisions or a max of 6 classes per day.

No class adds will be permitted within a division once that division is underway.
All adds/scratches must be done in the show office. NO GATE CHANGES.

Cross entries between arenas are allowed ONLY with coordination with gate personnel. There will be NO gate holds. Delay will result in automatic scratch with NO refund. Exhibition numbers will only be dispersed with signed entry blanks and receipt of credit card. Numbers follow the horse, a horse may have multiple riders.

USEF Rules apply, exceptions are the judges discretion. Management reserves the right to combine/cancel classes with less than 3 riders.

Boots with a heel are required for all riders. ASTM/SEI-approved helmet is required while mounted. Formal attire is not required, but is a sign of respect to the judge.

Braiding is not required.

No martingales permitted in flat classes.

Boots/polos on horses are permitted but may be penalized in hunter classes.

Food will be available on site for purchase both Saturday and Sunday.

JUMPER CLASS Tables

Table II, Sec 1: Timed round, no jump-off. Winner is fastest time with least faults.

Table II, Sec 2(c): First portion untimed. If no faults, continue without stopping to timed section. Winner is time in second portion with least faults.

Table II, Sec 2(b): First portion is about power – object is to jump clean. If clear (no bell rings), continue on to jump-off (speed) within 45 seconds. If bell rings, no jump-off, rider exits ring. Winner is fastest time with no faults in the jump-off.

Optimum Time (Table IV, Sec 1): Time Allowed is established and posted on jump course. Cleanest round closest to Optimum Time (over or under) wins.

0.65 m = 2'1"

0.70 m = 2'3"

0.75 m = 2'5"

0.80 m = 2'7"

0.85 m = 2'9"

0.90 m = 2'11"

0.95 m = 3'1"

1.00 m = 3'3"
